Dr. Philippe Spiess **Biography**

Dr. Spiess is a senior member in the department of Genitourinary Oncology, with dual appointment in the department of Genitourinary Oncology at the Moffitt Cancer Center and Research Institute as well as full professor in the Department of Urology at the University of South Florida. Dr. Spiess serves as the assistant chief of surgical services and the medical director of Virtual Lealth at the Moffitt Cancer Center of Page 1997. Health at the Moffitt Cancer Center. Dr Spiess has recently been appointed to serve on the NCCN board of directors as the Moffitt

clinical representative and to serve on their steering committee. He completed his urology residency at McGill University in Montreal, Canada and completed a 3-year urologic oncology fellowship at The University of Texas M.D. Anderson Cancer Center in Houston, Texas. Dr. Philippe Spiess' clinical and research interests are in the field of penile and kidney cancer and has several research study collaborations on national and international levels. Dr. Spiess has published over 400 peer reviewed manuscripts and has edited 8 textbooks in urologic oncology, with 3 of these being reference textbooks in penile cancer. He currently serves as the chair of publications for the Societe Internationale d'Urologie board of directors. Dr Spiess is the vice-chair of the NCCN panel on bladder and penile cancer, president of the Global Society of Rare GU Tumors, and as a panel member of the ASCO/EAU Penile Cancer Committee. Dr Spiess sits on several international editorial boards including serving as the deputy editor-in-chief of the SIUJ and as an editorial board member of Urologic Oncology: Seminars and Original Investigations, BJU International, Nature Reviews Urology, Canadian Journal of Urology, and the International Brazilian Journal of Urology as the video section editor. Dr Spiess has served as the chair of the American Urological Association core curriculum of education. He has been invited to deliver over 100 lectures and seminars at national and international conferences and symposia.
